

- Multi-disciplinary educational assessments

# School Readiness Plus - 4 year old Preschool

Age 4 by Sept 1, 2019

This is a year before kindergarten preschool option for students who live within the Birch Lake, Willow Lane or Vadnais Heights Elementary school

boundaries. In order to enroll in this preschool at a reduced rate, a student must meet one of the following eligibility requirements:

- **♦** Homeless
- ◆ Foster Care
- ♦ English Language Learner
- ◆ At-risk Early Childhood Screening score
- ◆ Free/Reduced Lunch
- **♦** Income

If your student does not meet any of these criteria, your child(ren) is still eligible to attend for a fee. The cost will be based on our School Readiness Plus sliding fee scale.

Preschool sections are either morning (9 - 11:45 am) or afternoon (1 - 3:40 pm). Limited transportation available. Please find more information regarding qualifications and/or costs on our web page at

# Welcome to Preschool

### 2019-2020 Preschool Registration

- ♦ Registration begins January 15
  White Bear Lake Area (WBLA) Preschool is accepting registrations for the 2019-20 school year. This brochure and registration form are available online at www.whitebear.ce.eleyo.com.
- ♦ For Currently Enrolled WBLA Preschool and ECFE Students Students participating in 2018-2019 classes as of December 15, 2018, priority preschool registration is open from Wednesday, January 2 until Thursday, January 10. Families will be notified if they do not receive their first class option.
- ♦ New Students not currently attending WBLA Preschool or ECFE classes may register beginning Tuesday, January 15.
- ♦ **Registrations** will be accepted online and in-person at Normandy Park Education Center.

Registrations MUST include the following items or your enrollment will not be accepted

- ♦ A non-refundable \$55 registration fee
- ♦ Copy of birth certificate (new families only)
- ◆ Current immunization record \***required every year**Fax: 651-653-3155

### Class Fees

All class costs are for the entire school year (Sept - May). Parents will be invoiced a monthly fee based on program costs. Payments are due the first day of each month. Nature Preschool fees are higher to cover the costs of a Ramsey County Naturalist.

## **School Readiness**

Your child may qualify for tuition assistance based on the following eligibility requirements which include:

- ◆ Income
- ♦ Homeless/Foster Care
- Home first language
- ♦ Health and development

# Pathway I Early Learning Scholarships

To be eligible for a scholarship, families must

- ♦ live in Anoka, Dakota, Hennepin, Ramsey, Scott, or Washington counties
- have a child(ren) who is 3 or 4 years old by September 1 of the current school year and not yet eligible for kindergarten
- have an annual income at or below 185% of the Federal Poverty
- have an Early Childhood Screening completed


# **How To Register for Preschool**

The White Bear Lake Area Schools Community Services registration is online. This sheet will walk you through the process for registering a student for Preschool.

If you have not previously had a Community Services & Recreation account on Eleyo create one at: www.whitebear.ce.eleyo.com

- Create your account or login with your email address and password. (Can't remember your log in? Select Forgot Password to reset password).
- Select the Community Services & Rec tile -or- Community Education
- Select Explore All Programs, White Bear Lake Area Preschool, and select Registration.
- Select New Contract. **New Contract**
- Select the Attending Child from the left side of your screen and confirm all information is up to date. Either edit the child's info or start registering.
- Can Pick up? Complete the Emergency Contacts and select If they are Authorized Pickups select Verify Contacts/Pickups
  - Select the class your child will be enrolled in, then Use Location & Continue
- Choose the days your child is attending, then Complete Schedule Set Up
- Answer all registration questions and select Complete Questions & Continue
- 10. Add a saved payment method for your registration Complete Registration fees and/or deposits then select

be ACH (checking or savings accounts) or Credit/Debit Cards



You will then receive a Pending Contract Request email. A 2nd confirmation email will be sent when your student has been placed in their class and your payment account will be charged.



#### Full-day 4 year old program

Bear FUNdamentals is a year-before-kindergarten program focused on providing fun, nurturing and safe opportunities for learning and play that prepare children for kindergarten. Located at Birch, Hugo, Lakeaires, and Otter Schools, the program runs from 9 am-3:45 pm with the option of registering for Extended Day hours before or after school.

Bear FUNdamentals focuses on children's emotional, social, physical and intellectual growth. Children work on listening skills, language and literacy, thinking and math skills, and social development through meaningful, interactive play. The program is staffed at a 1:10 ratio and taught by passionate instructors who encourage curiosity, discovery, and problemsolving in a stimulating, structured, and fun environment.

Families can register for school day or full day (6:30am-6:00pm) hours, three to five days per week. Students registered for a White Bear preschool course will receive a discounted price. Limited transportation is available from neighborhood stops.


